**DEFENDANT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION
TO MOVE THE START TIME TO COMMENCE MEDIATION**

Defendant UBER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. ("Uber"), pursuant to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and with the consent of Plaintiff's counsel, respectfully requests a three (3) hour enlargement of time to commence mediation proceedings. In support of this Motion, Uber respectfully states as follows.

1. Mediation in this case has been ordered for January 23, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. (DE 29).
2. Counsel for Uber is an AAA arbitrator on a commercial panel that has also been scheduled for final hearing on January 23, 2018.
3. This arbitration was scheduled prior to the entry of the DE 29 and due to an oversight in scheduling, undersigned is unable to commence the meditation in this matter until after 1:00 pm on said date.
4. Uber hereby moves for a three (3) hour enlargement of time to commence mediation.

5. Accordingly, counsel for Uber conferred with Plaintiff's counsel, and Plaintiff does not oppose the extension but asked that we file a motion instead of simply starting later.

6. This Motion is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, Defendant, Uber Technologies, Inc., respectfully requests the entry of an Order enlarging the time in which to commence mediation by three (3) hours on January 23, 2018, together with such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
